**Speaker:** **Judy B. Yorke, P.E., CPP**, President of Yorke Engineering, LLC, has extensive Air Quality Permitting and Compliance experience at aerospace, military, utility, and industrial facilities. She is a recognized expert on the SCAQMD's regulatory requirements including Title V, RECLAIM, and New Source Review and a member of the SCAQMD's Permit Streamlining Task Force. She has performed air quality projects requiring large facility auditing and compliance management planning; emission inventories; permitting; air pollution control systems; monitoring, record keeping, and reporting systems; health risk assessments; hazardous substance release planning; regulatory analysis and development; and agency negotiations.

**Summary:** The SCAQMD is now implementing modernization provisions included in the Air Quality Management Plan, and has adopted changes to Rule 1110.2 for engines and has proposed changes to Rules 1146 and 1146.1 for Boilers and Process Heaters. The revised Rule 1110.2 monitoring and reporting provisions have proven to be challenging for many facilities, with many implementation issues still under development. This discussion will include a brief description of the changes and lessons learned. In addition, the first year of AB 32 greenhouse gas mandatory reporting will begin next year, and facilities need to understand whether this may apply to them and what they need to do to prepare for this new reporting requirement.
